


How to use



First of all, unscrew and discard the cap on the extraction buffer tube carefully.

Put it in the tube-stand on the back of the box.






Next, open the swab package.

Insert the swab in one nostril. Insert the swab 2cm inside the nostril (hole of nose) toward the center of the face, put it on the nasal wall lightly, rotate it at least 5 times slowly and leave it as it is for around 5 seconds.





Repeat these steps in your other nostril.

Insert the swab 2cm inside the nostril (hole of nose) toward the center of the face, put it on the nasal wall lightly, rotate it at least 5 times slowly and leave it as it is for around 5 seconds.





Immerse the tip of the swab into the extract buffer tube.

Roll the swab at least 10-20 times while pressing the head against the bottom and side of the extraction buffer tube.






Leave the swab in the extraction buffer tube for 1 minute.

After 1 minute, roll the swab head toward the inside of the extraction buffer tube at least 5–10 times.

Dispose the used swab from the extraction buffer tube by squeezing the sides of the tube to extract the liquid from the swab.





Screw the nozzle cap tightly onto the extraction buffer tube.






Open the test cartridge.

Add 4 drops of the processed sample into the sample [S] well.

Do not handle or move the cartridge until the test is completed and ready for interpretation.
